Bicycle Ride Policy



- Schaumburg Bicycle Club bicycle ride participants are responsible for their own bicycles. Participation
 in a Schaumburg Bicycle Club Ride may be denied to someone failing to have a Bicycle in good
 working condition, or failing to have the proper safety equipment.
- The Schaumburg Bicycle Club REQUIRES each Bicycle Rider to wear an APPROVED SNELL or ANSI HELMET on ALL Club Bicycle Rides. Participation in a Schaumburg Bicycle Club Ride may be denied to someone failing to wear a Helmet.
- The Ride-Leader is Not Responsible for riders that leave the ride group or ride ahead of the Ride-Leader. All participants should remain within sight of the Ride-Leader.
- Any participant wishing to leave the ride group must inform the Ride-Leader.
- All Bicycle Ride Participants are required to operate their bicycle in a safe and orderly manner. Ride Participants must maintain a safe spacing and notify other participants of a maneuver that may result in a collision.
- The Schaumburg Bicycle Club does not allow the use of HEADPHONES during a Club Bicycle Ride.
- The Schaumburg Bicycle Club requires all club members riding their bicycle upon a Road or Highway to obey all Traffic Laws.
- All Schaumburg Bicycle Club bicycle ride participants must Stop for Red Traffic Lights and must Stop at all Stop Signs.
- Bicyclists may proceed, after yielding the right-of-way to oncoming traffic, through a red light that fails to turn green after waiting for at least 120 seconds.
- Schaumburg Bicycle Club Members riding bicycles upon a Roadway shall not ride more than 2 abreast. Persons riding 2 abreast shall not impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic on a roadway.
- When bicycling on a Trail all ride participants are require to follow the posted rules for that trail. (For Example: Some trails have posted speed limits or maybe one-way. Some trails may have special rules about Bicycles yielding the right of way to People Riding Horses or People walking on the trail.)
